Although Morocco is considered to be a relatively tolerant country, Christians still face persecution from both the government and their communities. Christians who openly share their faith risk imprisonment and those who convert from a Muslim background can lose their inheritance rights and custody of their children. Despite this, Morocco remains a stable oasis in the region with relative freedom for Christians.
