- 808,092 people in Emergency Relief, to follow Jesus in the most dangerous parts in the world, as they faced persecution, poverty, and war;
- 290, 950 people in Community Development, to follow Jesus by giving them the tools to stay in their communities and be the light of Christ.

As a growing and respected ministry that supports persecuted Christians in more than 70 countries, and with our vision to make a double impact to the Christians of the world, we’re excited to bring on someone who shares the same vision, strengthening our organisation by connecting with like-minded people, partners, and the community.

About the Role

Open Doors is seeking a Relationship Manager based in Adelaide. Our team is looking to expand the profile of Open Doors throughout South Australia, as we continue to connect with churches in Australia and New Zealand and serve persecuted Christians around the world.

In this position, the Relationship Manager will be responsible to build and maintain relationships with pastors, church leaders, church congregations, advocates, and donors. As a Relationship Manager, you will also support and coordinate strategies and campaigns to help grow networks and partnerships across Australia, manage and collaborate with others to achieve organisational KPI’s and participate in facilitating church leaders or groups to help educate others about Open Doors’ ongoing mission.

From time to time, you will be required to speak at Sunday events, conferences, or media interviews, which will require regular engagement with church pastors and leaders. The role includes some domestic travel.
